## PHY2048 - PHY2049 Overall Course Grade Formula

Your course grade is based on 100 maximum course points. Your overall course points are determined from the following four terms:

Exams (75\% of course grade): Your exam course points are given by

$$
\text { Exams }=\frac{(E x 1+E x 2+E x 3+E x 4)}{60} \times(75)
$$

Ex1, Ex2, Ex3 and Ex4 are your in-class exam scores (Ex4 is the cumulative final exam). All exams will have 15 problems each with one point per problem, giving a total possible of 60 exam points. Your course exam points $(\max =75)$ are computed by summing all exam scores, dividing by 60 , and then multiplying by 75 .

Quiz (20\% of course grade): Your quiz course points are given by

$$
\text { Quiz }=\left[\frac{Q_{S u m}=\sum_{i} Q_{i}}{0.9 Q_{\text {tot }}}\right] \times 20
$$

$Q_{i}$ is your quiz grade for the $i^{\text {th }}$ quiz. Each quiz will be graded on a scale of 5 points. The quiz grade is calculated as in the above formula. Here, $Q_{\text {sum }}$ the sum of all quiz scores, is divided by $0.9 \times Q_{t o t}$, where $Q_{\text {tot }}$ is the maximum total number of quiz points and 0.9 is a "forgiveness factor" that accounts for illness, missed classes, etc. The ratio is then weighted to give a maximum of 20 points.

Homework (5\% of course grade): Your homework course points are given by

$$
\text { Homework }=\left[\frac{H W_{\text {sum }}=\sum_{i} H W_{i}}{0.9 \times H W_{\text {tot }}}\right] \times 5
$$

$\mathrm{HW}_{\text {tot }}$ is the sum of the maximum homework scores. $\mathrm{HW}_{i}$ is your score on the $i^{\text {th }}$ homework assignment and $\mathrm{HW}_{\text {tot }}$ is the maximum possible score. The ratio, which includes the 0.9 forgiveness factor, then is weighted to give a maximum of 5 points.

H-ITT Bonus Points (max =5): Your HITT bonus points are given by

$$
H I T T=\left[\frac{H I T T_{S u m}=\sum_{i} H I T T_{i}}{0.8 \times H I T T_{\text {tot }}}\right] \times 5=
$$

where HITT is the sum of all your HITT points, HITT $_{\text {sum }}$, divided by the total number of HITT points possible, $\mathrm{HITT}_{\text {tot }}$, times the 0.8 forgiveness factor. The HITT bonus points are then weighted to count a maximum of 5 bonus points.

## Overall Course Points $=$ Exams + Quiz $+\mathbf{H W}+$ HITT
