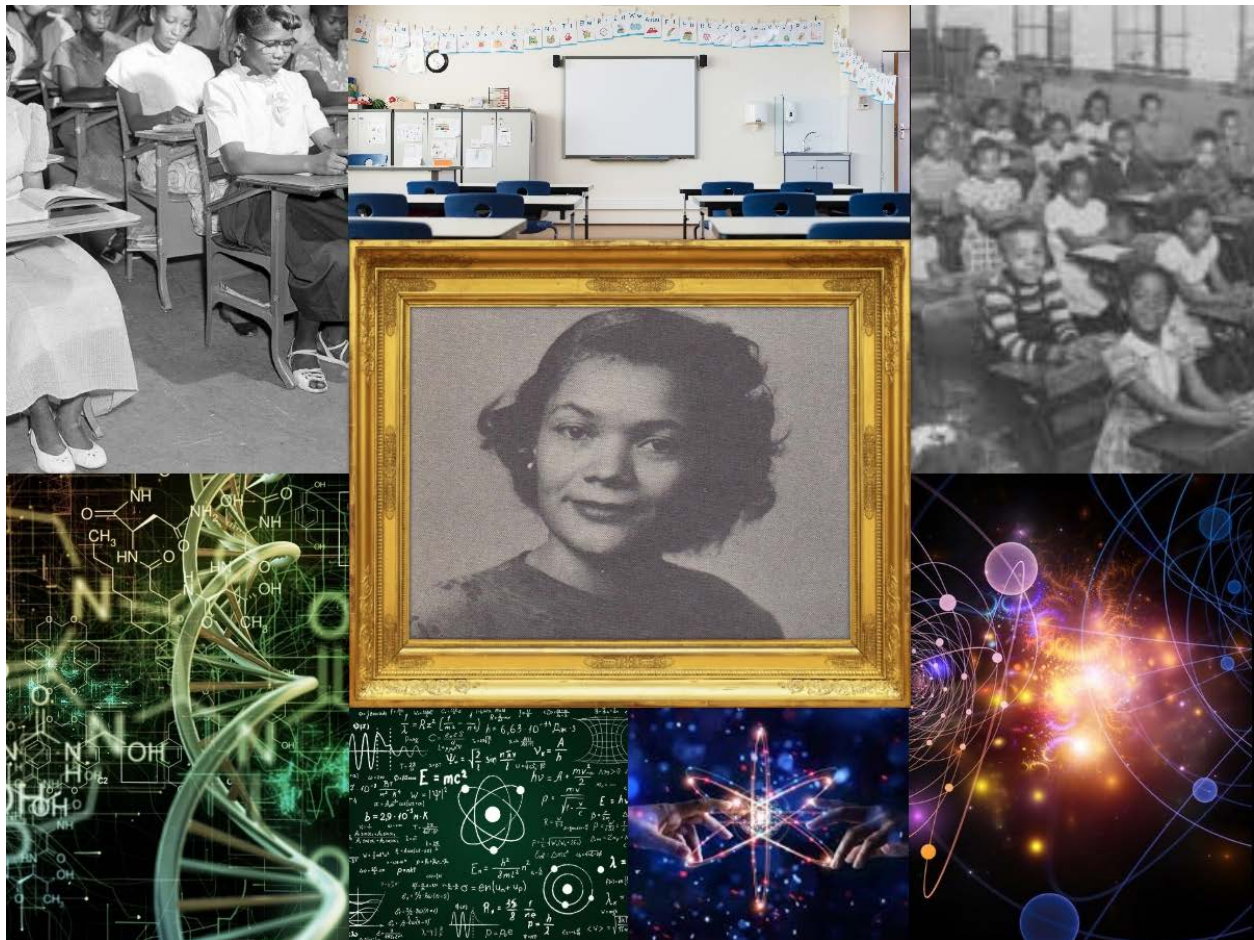


Carolyn Beatrice Parker, the unrecognised physicist
